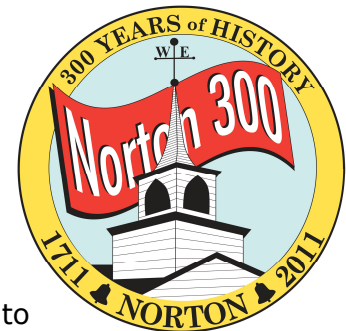

## Norton's Tricentennial Parade

As you know, the town is holding an anniversary parade on Sunday, June 12th at noon. The parade will start at the Yelle School on Route 123 and will end at the Solmonese School. Our council will be participating by entering a float which will seat about 15 members of our council and church. The float will be prepared at the parish center at 9:00am on Saturday, June 4th before it is covered in tarps until the day of the parade. Assistance is needed at that time to prepare the float (attaching pews, cross and bunting materials along bottom of float). This should not take long but again, many hands make light work.

If you plan on being in the parade, please try to wear, beige/light brown docker type pants (no shorts), your blue council shirt or a blue polo shirt. Sneakers or comfortable walking shoes recommended.





## Senior Luncheon

On Saturday, June 4, 2011, our council, in conjunction with the St. Vincent De Paul Society will be holding a senior luncheon at the parish center. 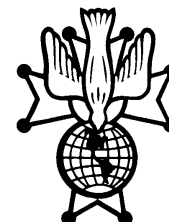
